Driving Directions



2115 Butterfield Road, Oak Brook IL 60523

Expect Delays: Midwest Road (22nd Street to Butterfield Road) is currently under construction. Traffic patterns have been implemented with one lane in each direction.

From the East:

Take I-290 West, continue in the left lanes onto I-88 West towards Aurora/Indiana, exit #15A. Go 0.5 mile, take the Roosevelt Road/I-294 South/IL-38 West exit towards Indiana. Go 1.0 mile - exit to the right to continue on Roosevelt Road/IL-38 West. Follow Roosevelt Road/IL-38 approximately 5.0 miles, turn left at the first stoplight, Summit Avenue. Continue south on Summit Avenue approximately 0.6 mile to Butterfield Road. Turn left onto Butterfield Road, go 0.1 mile to 2115 Butterfield Road. The Q-Tech Building is on your immediate right, the second driveway after you turn onto Butterfield Road.

From the West:

Take I-88 East towards Chicago, take the Midwest Road exit and turn right onto Midwest Road. Follow Midwest Road/Summit Avenue approximately 0.7 mile to Butterfield Road, and turn right onto Butterfield Road. Go 0.1 mile to 2115 Butterfield Road. The Q-Tech Building is on your immediate right, the second driveway after you turn onto Butterfield Road.

From the South:

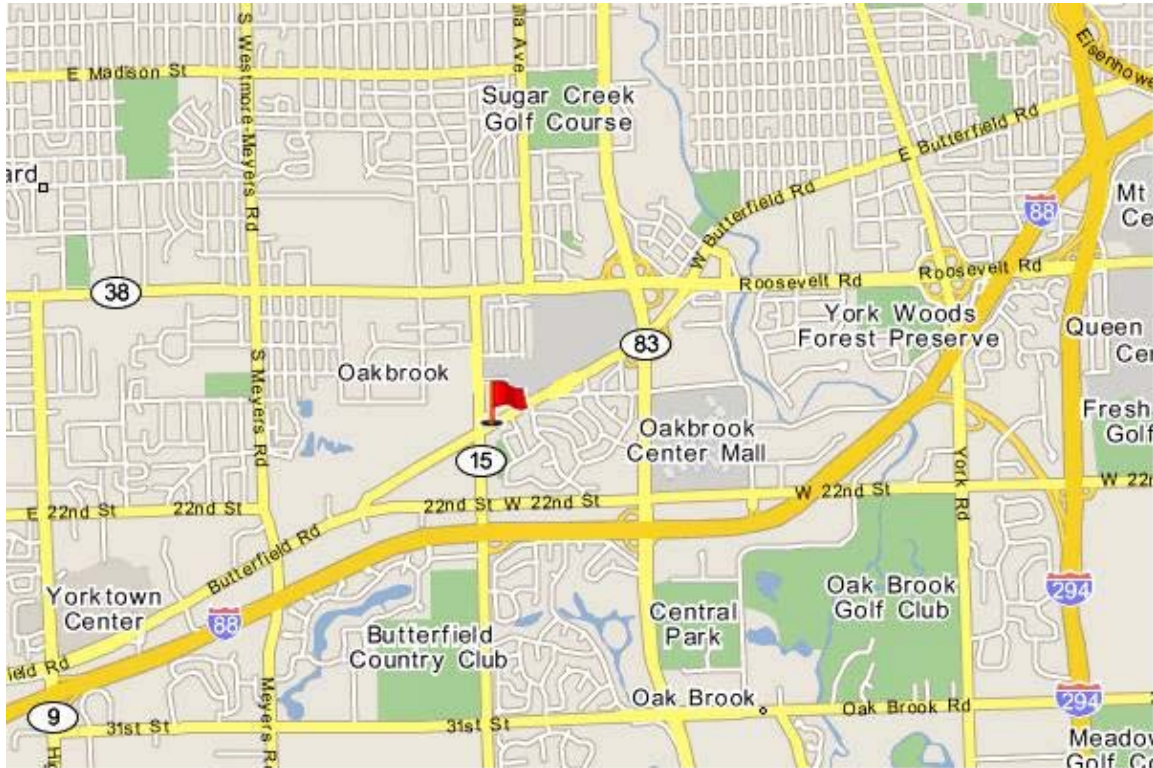
Take the Tri-State Tollway/I-294 North towards Wisconsin, and exit at Roosevelt Road/IL-38 West. Follow Roosevelt Road/IL-38 approximately 5.0 miles, and turn left at the first stoplight, Summit Avenue. Continue south on Summit Avenue approximately 0.6 mile to Butterfield Road and turn left onto Butterfield Road. Go 0.1 mile to 2115 Butterfield Road. The Q-Tech Building is on your immediate right, the second driveway after you turn onto Butterfield Road.

From the North:

Take the Tri-State Tollway/I-294 South towards Indiana, and take the I-290 West/IL-64/US-20 exit towards Rockford. Go approximately 3.0 miles, and take the IL-83 South exit #10A. Continue on IL-83 South approximately 4.0 miles, and exit onto Butterfield Road/IL-56 West. Continue on Butterfield Road approximately 0.7 mile to 2115 Butterfield Road. The Q-Tech Building is on your left before you reach the intersection of Midwest Road/Summit Avenue.
